Footnotes

RUNNING BEAR had speed between horses then stalked between foes, continued just off the rail into the stretch, came out past midstretch and rallied under urging to get up four wide late. PIERRE BEAR sent inside to stalk the pace, remained along the rail throughout and got up for the place. DAYLIGHT STORM wide early, stalked four wide then three deep on the turn and into the stretch, bid outside foes past midstretch, put a head in front in deep stretch and was edged late but held third between foes. TOWSER had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held well but was edged between foes. SEEUAT STICKNSTEIN chased between horses then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S ANDREW chased between rivals then a bit off the rail on the turn, angled inward into the

stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. LUCERO NEGRO broke a bit slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, came around a rival into the stretch and failed to menace. SENOR CRAFTY between horses early, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. ACTION CALL stalked between horses then outside a rival, came a bit wide into the stretch and weakened. BETTINGONTHETRUTH wide between foes early, chased four wide then off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a factor. ADROIT ONE dueled three deep then outside a rival, stalked on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive. TASTE OF SUCCESS sent between horses then settled outside a rival, found the rail on the turn and was not a threat.
