FIRE BREAK chased on the outside down the backstretch, was caught four wide on the second turn and into the lane, rallied outside through the drive and was up for the score on the wire. YVETT'S PRIDE found a good stalking position on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, took over the lead in midstretch and was edged at the wire in a game effort. DEVIL ON THE ROOF trailed the field to the top of the lane, swung out for the stretch drive and rallied on the outside in the final furlong to gain the show. OLIVER chased outside a rival down the backstretch, was three deep on the second turn and entering the lane, was between foes in deep stretch and lacked the necessary rally. SQUALLCREEK chased inside a rival down the backstretch, continued to save ground on the second turn, was between horses in deep stretch and could not make up the needed ground. YACHT SPOTTER sped to the early lead, maintained the advantage down the backstretch, opened up a bit on the second turn, remained in front in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DAY WITH DESI tracked the pacesetter around the first turn and down the backstretch, began to weaken on the second turn and gave way through the stretch drive.
