### Footnotes

RAIL TRIP stalked off the rail or between foes, bid between horses on the backstretch then outside ONE TRACK MIND on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away nearing midstretch and proved best under a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. SANGAREE stalked outside a rival or between horses, came out into the stretch and edged a foe for the place. SLEW'S TIZNOW close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, split horses nearing midstretch and was edged for second. SPURRIER broke in a bit, settled outside a rival then just off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the second turn, split horses in deep stretch and bested the others. CIGAR MAN chased off the rail, split horses on the backstretch, continued off the inside on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. ONE TRACK MIND sent between horses early, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. TRES BORRACHOS close up stalking the pace three deep, bid three wide on the backstretch, dropped back outside on the second turn and weakened. AITCHO settled inside then came off the rail on the first turn, went up four wide midway on the backstretch, fell back outside nearing the second turn and gave way.
