Footnotes

DANCE WITH GABLE angled in and set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the turn, maintained the advantage while tapped with the whip turned down several times and some hand urging and proved best. STONESIDE (IRE) stalked inside, bumped with a rival in midstretch, came out for room in deep stretch and edged a foe for second. QUIETLY MINE stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, was three wide through the final furlong and gained the show. BRADY BLUE EYES prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked off the rail then alongside a foe on the turn, was bumped when between horses in midstretch, continued between foes and steadied in tight nearing the wire. DAPPER GENE between foes early, chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FORMAT V. settled off the rail then along the inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
