**Footnotes**

VERY CAERLEON (IRE) settled off the rail, angled in and moved up on the turn, then rallied on the fence to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best under steady handling. FIVE STAR DAY sped to the lead inside, set the pace a bit off the rail and could not contain the winner, then returned bleeding in the mouth. KING OF TAP, settled off the inside, angled in some on the turn and picked up the show. WEST OF THE PECOS, sped to the lead then surrendered the advantage, stalked the pace off the inside and weakened. IRON CAL, four wide early, was well placed outside, angled in on the turn and lacked a late response. CLASSY SHEIKH, between horses early, stalked the pace off the rail and weakened. BOND was off a bit slowly and squeezed some, then saved ground but was outrun. NASA, also broke slowly, raced out from the inside and was not a factor. VECTOR ONE, settled toward the inside and gave way.
