Footnotes

GO YOYO dueled inside but a bit off the rail, inched clear leaving the turn and into the stretch, drifted out well off the rail in the stretch despite right handed urging but held. LAUREN'S HALO saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch, went around a rival in deep stretch and finished well. HOC YOUR SILVER chased off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, inched forward approaching the turn but was shuffled back some, bid inside in the stretch and held third. ASHLEY'S CAPER chased outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. FORTUNATE GLORY broke awkwardly, went up to duel outside on the backstretch and turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. GO FOR QUALITY off a bit slowly, was taken out from the rail, angled in early on the turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. CHELSEA'S GOLD went up to chase the pace between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, fell back leaving the bend and gave way.
