Footnotes

FIERY TRIPPI quickly sprinted to the front, set the pace along the inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted out through the drive despite right handed urging and won clear. MARQUET REBEL pulled between horses early, chased off the rail or outside a rival, came out into the stretch and just got the place. CHANGING (ARG) chased between foes then outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted out some from the whip in deep stretch and was edged for second. JOURNEYMAN hopped slightly at the start, went four wide into the first turn, chased three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, was between foes in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. SKIPPY DUE saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and did not rally. HARLENE angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. SEVENGOLDNMISSILES close up stalking the winner off the rail then a bit off the fence, was between horses into the stretch and weakened.
