Non-winners of \$300,000 at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$120,000 twice at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; such a race of \$90,000, 6 lbs.; Non-winners of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over, 8 lbs.; one such race 10 lbs. SANTA CATARINA settled inside then came off the rail on the backstretch, moved up outside a rival, continued outside on the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch and pulled clear under left handed urging and steady handling late. BUFFYTHECENTERFOLD stalked the leader along the inside, bid between horses into the stretch, drifted in past midstretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. PRINCESS V. sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail in upper stretch, then weakened but held third. MISS BRIDGET JONES pulled her way along a bit wide into the first turn, stalked off the rail then outside the runner-up, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. HARBOR BLUES stumbled at the start, settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and gave way.
