ADORATION four wide into the first turn, pressed the pace three deep then outside SAINT BERNADETTE on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead nearing midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. SISTER GIRL BLUES pulled a bit and was slightly crowded early, saved ground close up stalking the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and continued willingly but could not catch the winner. SAINT BERNADETTE broke in and bumped a rival, pulled her way between horses into the first turn, angled in on that bend, bid along the rail on the backstretch to take a short lead, dueled inside, fought back in the stretch and also continued on well to the end. LADYLORE broke in a bit, angled to the inside on the first turn, saved ground off the pace, advanced inside on the second turn and into the stretch, came out in midstretch and could not offer the needed late response. RESPECTFUL pulled a bit and went three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and weakened. ILE DE FRANCE sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled between foes on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and also weakened. RUNAWAY PRO bumped at the start, pulled her way along off the rail early, drifted wide on the backstretch, continued off the inside and failed to menace.
