ROCK OPERA pulled his way to the front and was rank on the lead inside on the first turn, set the pace inside, turned back a bid leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the lane, brushed with the runner-up through the final furlong but held on very gamely. CHISELLING saved ground stalking the pace, moved up inside on the second turn and into the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch, tried to slip through inside the winner but was in tight and brushed with that one in the final furlong and could not get by. EASY GRADES between horses early, stalked outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch, bid outside the winner on the second turn, could not quite match the top pair in the lane but held third. OLMODAVOR off a bit slowly, pulled his way between horses early then chased a bit off the rail, found the inside for the second turn and did not rally. DUDDLY DOO RUN three deep early, stalked the winner a bit off the rail or outside a rival, dropped back into the second turn and weakened. GREENHILLS (GB) off a bit slowly, settled outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and also lacked a rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run between the top pair but made no change when they ruled the runner-up was responsible for his own trouble.
