MINI SKIRT stalked the pace off the rail then bid four wide into and on the turn, gained the advantage outside a rival into the stretch and pulled clear in the final furlong under some urging. VINO TINTO dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn, continued inside into the stretch and just held second. THUNDER'S ECHO stalked the pace a bit off the rail, went outside PATRIOTIC DIVA leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and was edged for the place. CHAMP'S ROCKET unhurried along the inside early, came out on the turn, was forced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DELIZIA prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch and between horses on the turn, fell back some leaving the bend and weakened. PATRIOTIC DIVA prompted the pace inside, clipped heels at the quarter pole, came out into the stretch and was eased. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident at the quarter pole but made no change when they ruled the videotape failed to establish blame.
