SCOONERWHARFBARDOG between foes early, stalked a bit off the rail the inside on the turn, bid along the fence in the stretch to gain the lead past midstretch, inched away and held under left handed urging. HOLY LARK stalked the pace outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch and finished well. FRONT RUNNER pulled his way up inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front on the turn, inched away in midstretch, continued outside the winner and weakened some but held third. LAS VEGAS LUCKY angled in and stalked between horses, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. UNUSUAL MEN bobbled slightly at the start and was a bit crowded between horses early, chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. TRIBBLE sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. PAPA BRUSCHI between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch and lacked a further response.
