Footnotes

PICO PICO stalked inside then between horses on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied between foes under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. THE HUNT IS ON close up tracking the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch, gained the lead outside a rival nearing the sixteenth marker but could not hold off the winner. EXUMA five wide into the first turn, angled in and settled outside a rival, went four wide into and on the second turn and into the stretch and gained the show. ATTICUS POMPONIOUS saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and again in deep stretch and just missed third. BRASS PLATE settled inside then a bit off the rail, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. WARREN'S KONG chased between horses then off the rail on the second turn, steadied three deep off heels into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ABSOLUTE

COURAGE stalked off the rail then bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead a quarter mile out, inched away under urging in the stretch, had the rider lose the whip nearing the sixteenth pole and weakened. IMAGE AND LIKENESS fractious in the gate, had speed outside a rival then angled in, set a pressured pace inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. REGAL FEVER five wide into the first turn, angled in and stalked three deep to the stretch and weakened. GOLDEN JET stalked three wide or outside a rival, dropped back between foes on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
