Footnotes

FULL MOON MADNESS chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, came out three deep into the stretch, rallied to the front in deep stretch and proved best. THE MORRIS MONROE chased three deep on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied late outside for second. ALWAYS GAME sent along inside early, dueled along the rail, inched away briefly midway on the turn, fought back inside in the stretch, could not match the winner and lost the place late. SKY JACK vied for the lead between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch, put a head in front between foes in midstretch and was outfinished. SALBEN saved ground stalking the pace, was momentarily in a bit tight into the turn, continued along the rail and lacked the needed late response. ELEGANT FELLOW forced the pace three deep on the backstretch, dropped back a bit three across the course on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
