DROUGHT BREAKER between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn and took a short lead, kicked clear into the stretch and drew off under some urging and steady handling late. SPRING FESTIVAL sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, offered little resistance when challenged, drifted out into the stretch and weakened but held second. RUNAWAYSKYE broke slowly and steadied, angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and picked up the show. OUR SOUTHERN PEARL three deep early, chased off the rail, angled in on the second turn and lacked a further response. TITA EMERALD four wide early, angled to the inside and chased along the rail, remained inside in the stretch and also had no rally.
