KEVLAR KID showed the way into the first turn, opened a clear advantage a bit off the rail around the turn, maintained that edge down the backstretch and around the second turn, drifted out from the whip leaving the furlong marker and remained clear to the wire. WARNING SONG pressed outside the winner into the first turn, pulled while allowing that one to clear around the turn, stalked outside a rival down the backstretch and off the rail on the second turn, was asked to go after the leader at the quarter pole, could not run down the winner but was clearly second best. RED EYE EXPRESS (IRE) settled around the first turn, chased off the rail down the backstretch, moved closer on the second turn, was all out leaving the quarter pole and failed to mount the necessary rally. DO IT ALL saved ground around the first turn, chased inside a rival down the backstretch and around the second turn, remained on the inside through the stretch and weakened. CIGAR MAN was reserved around the first turn, angled off the rail down the backstretch, swung to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and had no rally.
