Footnotes

GILLIGAN took the early lead off the fence then angled in on the first turn, set a pressured pace inside then inched away on the backstretch, fought back when challenged again in the stretch and held on gamely under urging and strong handling. COURTSIDE ACTION prompted the pace outside the winner on the first turn, stalked off the rail then between horses leaving the backstretch, continued just off the inside on the second turn, re-bid alongside the winner in the stretch and battled willingly to the wire but could not get by. ASPERITY angled in early on the first turn then came out leaving that turn, pulled hard under stout restraint outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and edged a foe for the show. GREEN CARD JAMES four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, bid three deep five eighths out, continued to track outside a foe leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, was between horses through the final furlong and was outfinished for third. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) was in a good position stalking the pace along the inside throughout and could not summon the necessary response.
