**Footnotes**

MY BOY LUKE unhurried a bit off the rail to the second turn, advanced four wide on that turn and five wide into the stretch, gained the lead three deep under left handed urging in midstretch and gamely prevailed. COAL REGION KID five wide into the first turn, chased outside, moved up four wide then three deep splitting horses on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and continued willingly inside the winner. ALEX T dueled inside then stalked along the rail, re-bid from the fence into the stretch, battled inside the top pair, could not match those two late but held third. VOLACIOUS saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and was outfinished for the show. POINT MUGU broke out and bumped a rival, went four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, advanced four wide again into the second turn, was three deep into the stretch, was in a bit tight between foes in upper stretch and weakened. ENTERPRISE ZONE had speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, continued off the rail on the backstretch, inched away briefly on the second turn, was between foes into the stretch and also weakened. MALAGA COVE stalked between horses then outside on the backstretch, moved up three deep on the second turn, dropped back between foes leaving that turn and also weakened. SLEWS DARK KNIGHT stalked between horses then off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the backstretch, dropped back between foes on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. SWISS EMPEROR in a bit tight early, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. ALL DE VICTORS sent

along wide early, angled in outside a rival, dropped back on the backstretch, was pulled up into the second turn and vanned off.
