Footnotes

SILIC (FR) saved ground stalking the pace, split rivals into the stretch to gain the lead, kicked clear and held gamely under urging. LADIES DIN bumped early, settled three deep, dropped back some when fanned out six wide into the stretch but rallied gamely to just miss. SHARAN (GB) rank early, angled in and saved ground, came outside a rival into the stretch, split foes in midstretch and finished willingly. WHITE HEART (GB) pulled his way along and was in tight into the first turn, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, split horses into the stretch and again in midstretch with a late bid. . TAKARIAN (IRE) unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail to the stretch, also got through between horses in midstretch and put in a late bid. ELABORATE stalked the pace outside a rival or between horses, came out four wide into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. LORD SMITH (GB) saved ground unhurried, moved up some nearing the stretch, got through along the rail but also lacked the necessary late punch. MULA GULA chased three deep early, continued outside, came five wide into the stretch and had little left. FIRST TITANIUM sped to the early lead, set the pace inside until entering the stretch and weakened. MONTEMIRO (FR) squeezed at the start, angled in early when unhurried, came off the rail on the backstretch, circled six wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. AUCTION HOUSE four wide nearing the first turn, stalked the pace outside the winner, was between horses leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
