SEATTLE SHAMUS broke in and bumped a rival, chased a bit off the rail, moved up outside a foe on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead under left handed urging in midstretch and proved best under steady handling. POHAVE four wide early, pressed the pace three deep, took the advantage into the stretch but could not match the winner. R MEADOW LUCK angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and again into the stretch and picked up the show. TALARA bumped at the start, saved ground off the pace, also came out into the stretch and failed to menace. COCONUT MANGO had good early speed and dueled between horses, battled a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened. CANNON ONE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, was not a factor. ROCK COD JOHNNY had speed between horses then dueled inside, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened.
