WHAT A SONG stalked between foes then off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter leaving the turn, took command into the stretch and drew clear under a mild hand ride. STEVIE WONDERBOY stalked between horses on the backstretch and steadied in tight nearing the half mile pole, split horses into the turn, angled in on the bend, came out into the stretch and just got the place. BENGAL LORE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch, was no match for the winner and just lost second. VIA RODEO chased outside and four wide into the turn, angled in some leaving the bend and did not rally. ALWAYS ROYAL saved ground off the pace, moved up into the stretch, came out past midstretch and was not a threat. ORMAZD sent inside to stalk the pace, dropped back on the turn, came out into the stretch and wakened. RISEN RIVER stalked between horses, drifted out nearing the half mile pole, angled in some on the turn and gave way.
