Footnotes

LAVA MAN prompted the pace outside a rival then between horses, put a head in front midway on the second turn, inched away in upper stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. ANZIYAN ROYALTY stalked the early pace off the rail, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, could not quite match the winner in the stretch but continued willingly to the wire. SKUKUZA saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. BORREGO chased off the rail then outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHOCTAW NATION a bit slow to begin, angled in early then settled off the inside, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch but could not sustain the bid. MOLENGAO (BRZ) pulled his way along inside chasing the pace, saved ground to the stretch, went around a rival past midstretch and was not a threat. ACE BLUE (BRZ) had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened.
