WARREN'S TONY R. stalked the pace inside, came out in upper stretch, bid between horses past midstretch to gain a short lead and held gamely under urging. BLACKBRIAR chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid three wide past midstretch and edged a foe for second. POP'SHANDS ARE HOT sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside then kicked clear on the backstretch, fought back when challenged past midstretch and was edged for the place. SAINT CHOCOLATE angled in and chased inside, came out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. KAYAKITYAK three deep early, settled outside a rival on the first turn then off the rail, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. MORAL HAZARD broke outward and a bit slowly, went three deep into the first turn, prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked alongside a foe, dropped back between horses nearing midstretch and weakened. LITTLE STREET CAT pulled between horses and steadied on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, went three deep leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
