WYLIE N WYATT stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, gained a short lead past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. VALLEY CAT chased three deep then outside on the turn, went four wide passing the quarter pole and five wide into the stretch, drifted in some and went willingly to the wire between foes. FRANCONI a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail, swung five wide into the stretch and finished with interest between horses on the line. TRIBAL NATION allowed to settle off the inside, came out in the stretch and found his best stride late while five wide on the line. HUGS TO ALL sped to the early lead and lugged out, angled in some and dueled off the rail then between horses on the turn, regained the advantage into the stretch, fought back between foes in the drive and was outfinished. FULL EFFECT chased three deep then off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, lacked room briefly off heels in midstretch, split foes and also was outfinished. KOOLNQUICK dueled outside a rival then put a head in front three deep on the turn, battled three wide into the stretch, then weakened. SMOKEY WONDER broke alertly then dropped back outside, settled off the rail or outside a rival and did not rally. DANCE MARINO stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and weakened late.
