Footnotes

MACHO DORADO chased the pace inside a rival down the backstretch, then off the rail around the turn, angled out for the drive, went after the leader, took the lead in deep stretch and held for the score. SENATOR BOB dueled outside CHAMPAGNE TOPPER down the backstretch and into the turn, took a clear lead leaving the quarter pole, battled inside through the final furlong and was outfinished in the late stages while holding the place. WOODMANS LUCK chased inside a rival down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch three wide, could not offer the necessary rally but was a clear third at the wire. QUILLOTANO was off slowly, chased from the back down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, angled off the rail in the final furlong and passed tiring foes. CHAMPAGNE TOPPER moved up quickly on the rail to duel for the lead down the backstretch and around the turn, began to weaken approaching the quarter pole and fell back on the inside through the lane. CAHILL COUNTRY chased outside the winner down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch five wide and lacked the necessary rally. TWOATTEN TENATTWO was bumped between horses at the start, chased outside a rival down the backstretch, came into the stretch four wide and did not mount a bid.
