Footnotes

MORELL'S LOVE stalked the early pace outside, dueled outside CITY DOC on the turn, took a short lead in upper stretch, inched away from that one and held on gamely under urging. ICKSNAY between rivals early, dropped back while climbing a bit on the backstretch, split rivals on the turn and finished well. CITY DOC sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled inside the winner on the turn and in the stretch and weakened but held third. ANOTHER OLIVE, saved ground to the stretch, came out and put in a late bid at the show. WESTERN DAWN, settled off the rail, went up outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. MAGICAL GIFT pulled and was in a bit tight early, angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground the rest of the way and also weakened. MARQUEE'S PRIZED, between rivals early, dropped back off the rail on the turn and had little left.
