BRONZE ROUTE dueled four wide then three deep into and on the turn, took a short lead into the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. CHAMP'S ROCKET chased outside, bumped hard with a foe early on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and went willingly for second. POET'S STUDIO had speed between horses and dueled a bit off the rail, fought back inside on the turn and into the stretch and was edged for second late. TANTALLON crowded between foes just after the start, chased off the rail, steadied off heels early on the turn, came out in upper stretch and finished well. SHE'S MOVIN ON had good early speed and stalked inside, waited a bit into the turn, came out leaving the bend and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FABULOUS BONUS unhurried off the rail early, angled in some on the backstretch, came out in the stretch and improved position some. RED HAIR LADY dueled three deep between foes on the backstretch, continued between horses on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SCROFA allowed to settle outside on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. L. A. TOOTIE had speed between horses to press the pace, steadied when squeezed back into the turn, came out and bumped hard with a rival early on the bend, dropped back and gave way.
