Footnotes

NIGHT TIDE stalked early then bid three deep into and on the turn, had the leader slip away in the stretch, then came on again under some left handed urging and strong handling to gain the advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. A TOE BY THREE sent inside to take the lead on the backstretch, dueled along the rail on the turn, inched away while drifting in a bit in the stretch and could not contain the winner late. BLING CHA BLING chased three deep between horses then outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and picked up the show. DANGER RANGER between horses early, stalked off the rail, angled in some on the turn and lacked the needed rally. HE'S A BANDIT settled between rivals then angled to the inside on the turn and could not offer the necessary response. PEDLARS WAY wide early, chased four wide on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and off the fence into the stretch and also lacked the needed late kick. FOREST SOUVENIR sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled between horses on the turn and weakened in the stretch. TRAWEEK saved ground chasing the pace, steadied and came out off heels into the turn, angled back in and failed to menace. BUSTIN RUBBERBANDS a bit crowded soon after the start, pulled some and was in a bit tight a half mile out, steadied when forced out some into the turn, continued outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
