YOUNG THOMAS broke slowly and was bumped, saved ground off the pace, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up at the wire. BLACK MALLOU had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, stalked a bit off the rail then re-bid alongside that one leaving the turn, gained a short lead, inched clear in deep stretch but was caught late. RAZOR CUT stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside the runner-up in the drive and weakened in the final sixteenth but held third. STORMY GAME chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ZOOMIN ZABEL settled outside on the backstretch, went three deep into the turn, had the rider lose the whip in upper stretch and could not summon the necessary response. NEWTON'S MEMORY broke in onto foes, chased a bit off the rail, split horses into the turn and did not rally. RAINGEAR broke slowly, was bumped and forced inward, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. MARKET EXCHANGE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, fought back leaving the bend but weakened in the stretch. BUILT FOR THEDERBY broke slowly, was bumped and steadied between foes, settled outside the winner, dropped back a bit off the rail on the turn and was done early.
