Footnotes

LEROY'S DYNAMEAUX settled off the rail, went outside on the second turn and five wide into the stretch, rallied while drifting out some under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and held. BOGIE (IRE) broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled inside, went outside the winner on the backstretch, waited a bit off heels midway on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch, angled out again and finished well to just miss. MACIAS pulled his way along to duel three deep, inched away leaving the first turn, set the pace off the rail, found the inside approaching the second turn and held on well through the stretch but could not quite finish with the top pair. HUDSON LANDING chased outside a rival went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, continued between foes through the drive and was outfinished. DREAM NETTIE was in a good position chasing the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, split horses leaving that turn, found the inside again into the stretch and also was outfinished. CAMP VICTORY pulled between horses to duel for the lead then stalked a bit off the rail, was between rivals again in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. WHO'S UP chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, continued three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was between horses in the drive and lacked the needed rally. UKANDOIT dueled inside then stalked along the rail, dropped back leaving the second turn and also weakened.
