Weights Sunday, June 15. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Breeders' Cup Limited shall also present a trophy to the winning owner.

TIZ WEST chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the backstretch, bid three deep to briefly put a head in front, dueled three wide, gained another slim advantage into the stretch, drifted in and fought back through a stiff drive and gamely prevailed along the inside under urging. EZ DREAMER chased a bit off the rail then outside the winner, was forced out some on the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside, drifted in through the final furlong and narrowly missed. LIBERIAN FREIGHTER pulled his way along to duel outside a rival, put a head in front between foes leaving the backstretch, fought back between rivals until deep stretch and weakened late but held third. ROBSCARVIC (IRE) angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. POLONIUS bobbed slightly at the start, pulled a bit on the early lead, dueled inside, fought back when headed but weakened in the final furlong. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference on the backstretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident occurred at a point in the race that did not alter the original order of finish.
