FREE BEER four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace outside, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the lead, drifted in and held on gamely under urging. SOVEREIGN LORD broke in and bumped a rival, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch, also

drifted in, bid alongside the winner under urging then had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out and could not get by. COLD RULER chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses into the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. PERFECT PAL stalked inside, waited off heels into the stretch, split rivals in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. NUMBER ONE EDITION broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled inside, moved up inside foes then between rivals on the backstretch, continued just off the rail on the second turn and lacked the needed late response. PERKINS stalked off the rail bid outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. FIRE SCOUT sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn and under urging into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and also weakened. YOU'RE NO GOOD bumped at the start, saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked a response in the stretch. SPENDAMILLIONBUX five wide into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. CRESTLINE broke slowly, angled in then settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. EASY PLUNDER four wide early, settled outside or off the rail, dropped back and angled in some on the second turn and had nothing left for the stretch.
