TOPPER SHOPPER was sent along inside to duel for the lead, inched away a half mile out, kicked clear in the stretch and held under left handed urging. NOBLETY chased inside on the backstretch and turn, came out a bit past midstretch and finished willingly outside the winner. RON BOB AND DAVE stalked the pace outside, went four wide leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and edged a rival for third. MAUI MARK settled a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, was in tight off heels in upper stretch, waited behind rivals in midstretch, came out again and just missed the show. SLAM SLEW stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed response. DODGEN BULLETS prompted the pace outside the winner then stalked, was outside a rival leaving the backstretch, was forced out a bit into the turn, dropped back leaving the bend, steadied into the stretch and weakened.
