HOPE ISLAND broke a step slow, recovered quickly and rushed up from the inside to grab the lead, continued to maintain cushion from the inside and responded from strong handling to safely hold. MEMORANDA chased from the inside early, slipped through inside SQUALL LINDA entering the stretch, could not collar the leader but outdueled rival for the place. SQUALL LINDA forced the pace into and around the turn, raced three wide into the stretch, could not match the winner late and just lost the place. PERT LAURA reserved just off the rail early, continued inside and finished willingly. DELICIOSA (ARG) prominent early from the outside, raced two wide around the bend, drifted out and was four wide into the stretch and never menaced. DYNA'S CLUB stumbled in the opening strides, settled off the early pace, drifted out into the stretch and lugged out through the lane. BATTY QUEEN (ARG) lagged back in the early stages, raced three wide around the bend and into the stretch and completed a racing rarity with 1-2-3-4-5-6-7 finish.
