VENEDA LUCY sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and held on gamely under left handed urging and strong handling. CAN YOU IMAGINE stalked outside then angled in off the rail, inched closer in the stretch, could not catch the winner but bested the others. GIRLY GIRL chased between horses then off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch and just held third. BLAZEN BUNNY saved ground chasing the pace, came out nearing midstretch and was edged for the show. TRUE HEAT close up stalking the winner inside, remained inside in the stretch and weakened. MISSANNALOUISE unhurried outside a rival then off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. HAVE AT IT chased outside, angled in alongside a rival leaving the turn and lacked a further response. DIXIE PIXEL off a bit slowly, settled inside, remained on the rail in the stretch and was outrun.
