### Footnotes

SWEPT OVERBOARD a bit slow into stride, raced unhurried outside a rival to the stretch, came out in midstretch and closed with a rush under good handling to prove best. KING SLAYER (GB) chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and split horses late for second. LAKE WILLIAM was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, also came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and held third. GIBSON COUNTY sped to the early lead outside a foe, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, was no match for the winner in deep stretch and lost a minor award late. IMPRESSIVE GRADES raced unhurried along the inside to the stretch, remained inside and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. MCCORDNSKUBA saved ground stalking the leader, came out into the stretch and weakened.
