ROAR BABY ROAR pressed the pace three deep into the turn, reached even terms with the pacesetter at the top of the stretch, took over the lead and drew clear in the final furlong. WARREN'S AMBER chased off the rail then three deep into the turn, moved closer around the turn, came into the stretch three wide and rallied though the final eighth to gain a clear second. MOLLY'S ALL HEART showed speed between horses into the turn, opened up an advantage inside around the term, was challenged by the winner at the top of the lane and weakened through the final furlong. BEST PRESENT EVER was hustled between horses in the early going, steadied when in tight entering the turn, kept to her task into the stretch, angled outside in midstretch but lacked the necessary rally. PLATINUM RULES vied for the lead inside a three horse spread into the turn, was steadied leaving the quarter pole while on the inside and fell back through the stretch run. GYPSY FRIDAY off a bit slowly, steadied off heels while in tight on the inside entering the turn, swung wide around the turn, remained widest in the stretch and made no impact.
