DA MARSHALL had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, put a head in front in the stretch, fought back between foes a sixteenth out and inched away under urging. POLLY'S DANCER pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes at the sixteenth pole, could not match the winner late but gained the place. BEAU MAVERICK chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, bid between foes a sixteenth out and clearly bested the others. BOLD TYPE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and until past midstretch, then weakened. UNBRIDLED SCORE broke alertly but bobbled, dropped back between foes then off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out in upper stretch, angled in again and did not rally. IRISH CORAL pulled his way along three deep to prompt the pace then stalked off the rail, continued outside the runner-up on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
