LUCKY PRIMO had good early speed and dueled inside, regained the advantage into the second turn, inched away leaving that turn, drifted out some from the whip while drawing clear in the stretch and held under right handed urging late. NORVSKY settled inside then a bit off the rail into the second turn, went outside a rival on that turn, came out in the stretch and gained the place. RENEGADE STORM saved ground off the pace, came out a bit in the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and bested the others. BATON ROO three deep early, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled to the inside nearing the second turn and was not a threat. LOGICAL SINGLE pulled her way along outside the winner to duel for the lead, drifted out a bit into the backstretch, took a short advantage, battled alongside that rival into the second turn, stalked off the rail leaving that turn and weakened in the stretch.
