FLAMETHROWINTEXAN sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled outside a rival into and on the turn and into the stretch, inched away under urging in midstretch and proved best. RODEO SHOPPER unhurried off the rail early, angled in on the backstretch, moved up inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and rallied for second. ROCKIN THE SHIP broke out a bit, stalked inside then bid along the rail leaving the backstretch, dueled inside the winner on the turn and into the stretch, came out in midstretch and held third. GOLD BANKERS GOLD stalked three deep then outside into and on the turn, angled in a bit leaving the bend and did not rally. LONGGONETREVERSEAN stalked the pace between horses then off the rail, lugged out and steadied leaving the turn and weakened.
