Footnotes

MATTY G WHIZ five wide early, stalked outside then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into the stretch, took the lead and kicked clear and proved best under urging. HONEELUV DROP unhurried off the rail then inside, saved ground on the turn, moved up inside into the stretch and split horses late for the place. DIXIE COURAGE chased between horses then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. VIRGINIA CITY sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. LAZER PARK chased between horses then off the rail, went outside a rival into the turn, angled inward in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LOLLAPALOOZA was in a good position stalking the pace inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and weakened. BANDERA NEGRA stalked outside a rival then between foes into the turn, continued outside a foe on the bend, came out in late stretch and also weakened. BELONG TO PARFAIT chased between foes then four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
