Footnotes

GLASSY stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn, gained the lead into the stretch and pulled clear under left handed urging. ARRABIATA GRACE (BRZ) chased inside then outside a rival, angled to the rail in the stretch and gained the place. ALL AGLOW had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, fought back on the second turn, drifted out some in the stretch and held third. THE WAGES OF SIN saved ground off the pace, came out three deep on the second turn, angled back to the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BLAZING BARTOK prompted the pace outside a rival then between foes on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PAPANAZZI CHARM (NZ) chased outside a rival then between horses leaving the second turn and did not rally. SIZZLING SARAH angled in and chased inside, remained on the rail in the lane and weakened. ONE CHARMING DEVIL saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn, came out in the stretch and also weakened.
