Footnotes

GREELY'S GHOST sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, kicked clear under urging in the stretch and proved best. ZILARATOR four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then alongside a rival, continued just off the fence on the second turn and into the stretch, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. BODY BUILDER broke a bit slowly, split horses on the first turn then settled inside, moved up along the rail into and on the second turn and into the stretch and held third. ST. JOEL chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the backstretch and three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. PHILLY SLEW allowed to settle outside, also went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. QUIETLY WAITING saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SOUVENIR SUMMER three wide into the first turn, angled in and chased just off the rail, found the inside on the second turn and weakened. WARRENS TEMPTATION pulled his way between horses then prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked between rivals on the backstretch, dropped back into and on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. SPINCO BOB angled in on the first turn and stalked inside then just off the fence, continued outside a rival on the second turn and also weakened.
