Footnotes

POCKETFULLOPESOS stalked a bit off the rail then inside, was in a bit tight early on the turn, got through inside into the stretch, gained the lead and proved best under urging. COCONUT GIRL settled off the rail then outside a rival, angled in on the turn, waited off heels in midstretch, then got through inside for second. BRITE SUNNY DAY forced the pace outside a rival then three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and held third. RICH MUSIQUE had good early speed and dueled inside, battled between horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. ASK NOT stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, bid four wide into the stretch and also weakened. CALZADA KID saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally.
