**Footnotes**

KING'S CHARMER stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out in upper stretch and rallied under urging to get up. SKIPPADOO bumped hard at the start, went up between horses then duelled outside a rival, regained the advantage into the stretch but was caught late. DESERT TENT saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for third. ALEXANDER CHARLOTE (IRE) off a bit slowly, chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, split horses in midstretch and again late and missed the show. MYSTERY MOUNTAIN bumped and bobbed at the start, had speed between horses then duelled inside, put a head in front on the turn but weakened in the final furlong. MILK RIVER chased outside then split foes three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn, angled in leaving the bend and lacked the needed rally. CASUAL FASHION between foes early, settled off the rail, split horses on the turn, angled in leaving the bend and could not summon the necessary late kick. FARNHAM stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and weakened. TETON NATIONAL chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. KEEP ABREAST chased a bit off the rail then inside, dropped back on the turn and also weakened. ROMACA allowed to settle outside then four wide leaving the backstretch, angled in some on the turn and did not rally.
