MEGAHERTZ (GB) angled in and settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the second turn, split horses in upper stretch, rallied under a couple taps of the whip to gain the lead past midstretch and held gamely under good handling. WINENDYNME between horses early, stalked outside a rival, went up three deep into the second turn, continued outside a foe into the stretch, came out some and went on willingly to the end. HALO OLA (ARG) pulled her way along to press or stalk the pace early, continued a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in leaving the second turn, came out past midstretch and finished well for third. FIVE NICKELS took the early lead between horses, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away again in the stretch but was outfinished. AGATA (FR) pulled early, went three deep into the first turn then stalked outside a rival, continued inside into and on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. URAIB (IRE) pulled between horses early, angled in through the stretch the first time, came out on the backstretch, went four wide into the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response.
