Footnotes

THE DEMPSEY LOOK chased between foes then angled in leaving the backstretch, found the rail on the turn, went around a rival into the stretch and rallied inside under good handling to get up late. ABSOLUTE NECTAR sped to the early lead, dueled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear into the stretch, came a bit off the rail and held on well but was caught near the wire. SPIRITED stalked the pace off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and continued willingly to the end outside the top pair. IRON FLIGHT dueled outside the runner-up on the backstretch, stalked that one a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened. CONCEAL THE DEAL chased three deep then angled in leaving the backstretch, continued inside on the turn, steadied when crowded as the winner went past into the stretch and lacked a further response. MARY SWANSON saved ground off the pace, dropped back on the turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace.
