Footnotes

CORONADO'S PRIDE sent inside to duel for the lead, inched away a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, drifted out into the stretch, continued to drift well out in the track despite right handed urging in the stretch but held sway. SETH THE CANDEYMAN dueled outside the winner, stalked off the rail into and on the turn, was fanned out five wide into the stretch, drifted out some then was floated to the far outside through the drive and could not get by. COURTLY JAZZ chased outside or alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. OUTSIDE LOOKING IN a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RENEGADE CIELO stalked a bit off the rail then inside, remained on the rail in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. PROUD HERITAGE was in a good position tracking the pace a bit off the rail, was between horses into and through much of the stretch and did not rally. THE RYE MAN broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a rival into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run between the top pair but made no change when they ruled both runners drifted out and the rider of the runner-up was not forced to stop riding during the incident.
