CONNAGHER quickly moved to the early lead, dueled inside RUMMYSECRET WAR down the backstretch and around the turn, drew away from that rival at the top of the lane, opened a clear lead and held WOODLAND FLOOD safe at the wire. WOODLAND FLOOD broke in and bumped a rival in a bit of a slow start, chased on the inside to the stretch, angled off the rail leaving the furlong marker and held the place. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER chased on the outside down the backstretch, came into the lane three wide, bumped with EXCLAMATION at the three sixteenths marker, continued willingly to the wire and just missed the place. RIVER ECHO broke slowly and awkwardly and steadied when bumped, was outrun to the lane, swung out for the stretch drive and passed tiring foes. EXCLAMATION (GB) stalked outside the dueling leaders down the backstretch, came into the lane between horses, bumped with a foe at the three sixteenths marker and weakened through the final furlong. RUMMYSECRET WAR dueled outside the winner down the backstretch and around the turn, lost touch with that one at the top of the lane and fell back through the final furlong. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start of RIVER ECHO and ruled that he was the cause of his own trouble.
