JUDGE JOAN stalked the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter past midstretch, gained a short lead under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. STORMY LINDA sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then angled in a bit off the fence, fought back in the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. ROMAN CHARITY hopped slightly in a slow start, was taken out three deep on the backstretch, continued to stalk outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch and finished well. MISS PEANUT pulled her way along between horses then chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COOL HALEIGH angled in on the backstretch and stalked inside, remained along the rail in the stretch and weakened. LINE ONE tugged her way along inside chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened.
